The First Day of School: What to Bring 2021/2022

All Children:

1. **Three complete changes of clothes** (to be changed in the event of accidents, wetness, or any bodily fluids)- Includes tops and bottoms, underwear, socks. Please label all clothing and place in your child's plastic cubby box
2. One pair of shoes, spare pair of gloves/mittens and hat for cold weather.
3. Printed photos:
 - a. One 4x6 headshot photo of your child for his/her cubby
 - b. One 8x10 photo of your child for his/her artwork (2s only)
 - c. One 4x6 photo of each parent
4. COMPLETED CHILD & ADOLESCENT HEALTH EXAMINATION FORM
5. COMPLETED EMERGENCY CONTACT FORM
6. COMPLETED DAYCARE CUMULATIVE HEALTH RECORD (new families only)
7. COMPLETED CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION FORM (new families only)
8. CHILDREN IN DIAPERS: Send in one package of diapers or pullups ("easy open" velcro sides only please) and one box of wipes, labeled permanently with your child's name. Teachers will let you know when the supply needs to be replenished.

Full Day Children (resters) only:

A clean, gently used fitted cot sheet will be provided for all full day students at the beginning of the school year. We reuse sheets to reduce textile waste. If you would like to purchase a new fitted cot sheet, let Sarah Brown know. New sheets are \$25.00, and will be added to your final bill. Bedding will be sent home weekly to be laundered by families.

Please include the following items in a small cloth bag clearly labeled with your child's name:

- a. A small blanket (crib-sized works well) labeled with your child's name.
- b. If your child is used to sleeping with a soft stuffed animal or comfort item, you can pack ONE comfort item. Please no interactive toys or anything that makes noise!
